### Warm Weather is Approaching... Dress Appropriately

- Students should wear clothes that are "clean, decent, and comfortable." That means midriffs and cleavage should not be exposed, nor should boxer shorts be visible by low-slung pants.
- Spaghetti straps are not allowed and bra straps cannot be exposed. **Off-the-shoulder tops with spaghetti straps or bra straps exposed are not acceptable.**
- **Shorts and skirts can be 3 inches above the knee- no shorter.**
- Only closed toe shoes/sneakers are permitted. **Open-toed sandals, flip-flops or other footwear with the toes exposed are NOT allowed.** This is a safety issue towards fewer toe/foot injuries on the playground, during class activities, and in passing in the halls.
- Clothing should not have logos relating to alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illegal activities or other information or illustrations that may be in poor taste or deemed inappropriate for school.
